PROGRAM AIMS:

The EAPE program has been specially designed for non-native Spanish speakers who need to learn the language or increase their Spanish language skills whether for academic or personal purposes. **We encourage students that have an interest and desire to take these classes to increase their language skills.**

COURSES:

All levels of the course are aimed at emphasizing communication, speaking and writing skills by using Spanish as the main language in grammar, writing and culture classes. For advanced and intermediate levels in particular, the study of Mexican literature is a great asset.

ABOUT EAPE:

EAPE Spanish for Academic Purposes course offers three different levels:

Beginners ✓

Intermediate ✓

Advanced ✓

Each level is limited to a maximum of 20 students. Small groups guarantee better quality of teaching and closer rapport between student and teacher.

SCHEDULE:

- Courses are offered three times a year.
- Each course is twelve weeks long.
- The courses begin in January, May and August.

REQUIEREMENTS:

- Minimum age 18 years old.
- Motivation letter to attend the course.
- Letter of recommendation.
- A photocopy of passport valid for at least 1 year.
- Tuition fee payment.
- Medical insurance for the complete stay of the student
- Fill the Student Application Form (website).
- Spanish Placement Test (applied at the University upon arrival)



HOUSING:
